
Multi-Channel BFBS Digital TV Receiving Equipment (Kanadahaar, Camp Bastion, Lashkar Gar, FOB Price)



The BFBS multi-channel digital TV service conforms to UK Digital standards and so any UK digital 'freeview' equipment that carries the digital tick will work for BFBS transmissions.

As when installing a TV in the UK, you will require an external TV aerial in order to receive good quality TV reception.

A TV aerial, mounted at a reasonable height externally, will give you good line-of-sight reception to the local TV transmitter. It will also provide discrimination against unwanted interference and the necessary receive gain to get a good quality signal.

Internal aerials seldom work well, if at all. The accommodation units are either metal boxes or foil lined tents, good reception can only be achieved by using an external aerial.

There are many ways to enjoy BFBS Multi-Channel Digital TV, but the most common ways are:

1. Portable CRT TV and Freeview Set Top Box



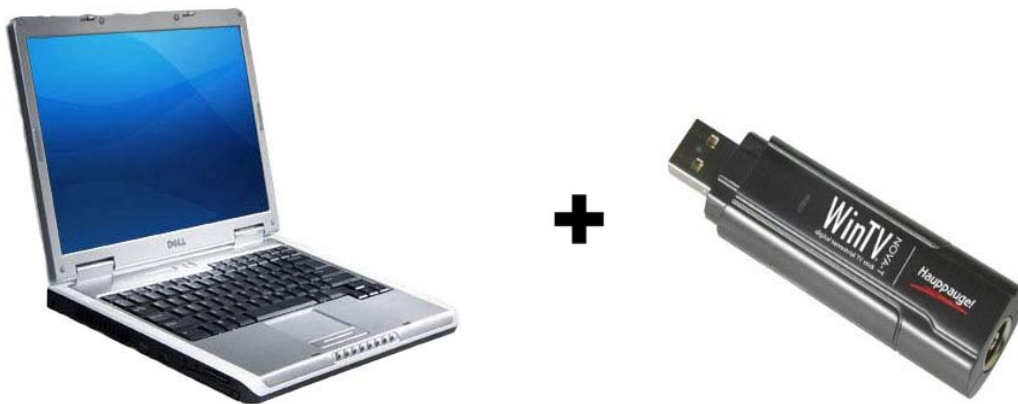
BFBS Technology use 'Sagem' DTT settop boxes as we have found them to be very reliable and stable.

2. Flatscreen TV with integral DVD and Freeview Receiver



Any integrated TV with the Digital Tick will work with BFBS transmissions.

3. USB DVB-T Stick for LAPTOPS



BFBS Technology use Hauppauge WinTV DVB USB sticks as we have found them to be very reliable and the full size aerial connector makes it very easy to connect to an external aerial for good reception.

4. Variety of Portable DVB-T Viewers



Of course, regardless of which of the above methods you decide to use to receive BFBS Digital Multi-Channel TV, you will require the following.

CO-AXIAL CABLE,



UHF / F-Type CONNECTORS



AERIAL MOUNT
